

EVACUATION ORDER
BRADLEY CREEK ZONE AREA

08/01/2026 AND TIME 1700 hrs

Pursuant to Band Council Resolution dated AUGUST 1, 2026, an Evacuation Order has been issued by Okanagan Indian Band due to immediate danger to life safety caused by the Wildfire of Bradley Creek.

Members of the Okanagan Indian Band, Fire Dept/bylaw and other applicable agencies will be expediting this action.

YOU MUST LEAVE THE AREA IMMEDIATELY

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- For traffic going south register at the Emergency Support Reception Centre at the Westbank Lions Club address is 2466 Main Street, West Kelowna.
- For traffic going north register at the Vernon Elks Lodge, 3103 – 30th Street, Vernon, BC
- If you need transportation assistance from the area, advise the person providing this notice or call: (250) 306-1553
- Shut off all gas and electrical appliances, other than refrigerators and freezers.
- Close all windows and doors.
- Close gates (latch) but do not lock.
- Gather your family and, if you have room, take a neighbour or someone needing transportation. Do not use more vehicles than you have to.

- Take critical items (medicine, purse, wallet, and keys) only if they are immediately available. Take pets in pet kennels or on leash.
- Do not use the telephone unless you need emergency service.
